#### **Changes to Booking to note:**

- Please arrive 20 minutes early for all Dinners to allow time to be seated.
- All Evenings (Halls, Dinners, Special Dinners, Feasts) are now only available to book from 9am on the Friday 2 weeks before the Event date.
- We will no longer be offering 'last minute' swaps of names or dietary information. This
  must all be submitted prior to booking closing on <u>St Cross Meal booking</u> or by email to
  mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk.
- Children are welcome to attend **all** lunches at the College. Those under 12 are free of charge and do not need to be booked in.

#### **Family Hall**

- When booking please specify if you need a high chair/booster seat. We will do our best to meet this need but only have minimal equipment. Where possible, please bring your own.
- Please specify your child's age in their booking. Under 12's will be charged at the rate of £6 each for catering. 12+ will be considered an adult for catering purposes.
- Where you have a specific dietary need (such as formula or baby food), please be aware
  that we cannot warm bottles etc. We will also need to provide a waiver for you to bring in

  this for you and book your child in for free.

#### **Booking Terms and Conditions:**

- All members must present their St Cross College ID Card upon entry to all events.
- All bookings for dining events should be made online: <u>St Cross Meal booking</u>.
- All bookings must be paid for at time of purchase, except for lunch walk-ins.
- If you wish to sell your ticket to another St Cross Student, you must submit this information before booking closes to <a href="mailto:mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk">mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk</a> We cannot take swaps or dietary changes after this time.

#### Fellows:

- Priority booking is now available to all Fellows prior to the bookings opening.
   Please email <a href="mailto:mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk">mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk</a> with your dinner choices before <a href="mailto:Monday">Monday</a>
   6 January 2025 at 8.30am.
- GB Fellows are entitled to 2 free dinners per term.

#### Halls:

- Bookings close on Friday the week before your event at 10am.
- There is no seating plan for Halls but you should arrive with those you wish to sit with.
- Wine bottles must be purchased at the time of booking. Please choose between:
   House White & Red Wine at £12. Marcel Martin Chardonnay & Paparuda Pinot Noir at £14.

#### **Dinners. Special Dinners and Feasts:**

- Bookings close each Friday at 10am. Cancellations after this time are charged.
- Only one Special Dinner booking per term is permitted. Extra bookings will be cancelled.
- For the **Feast** only one booking per member is permitted and no guests are allowed.
- Junior Members are entitled to one discounted Feast place per academic year at £20.00. Any further Feast bookings will be charged at £33.79 (plus £18.50 for alcohol).
- Wine is sold "paired with meal" for Special Dinners, Feasts, and Tasting Dinner & Governing Body Dinner.
- Any student that cancels (after the permitted cancellation time)/fails to attend a Special Dinner will be precluded from any future Special Dinners for the term.

#### **Guests:**

- Members can bring 3 guests for the Halls, Special Dinners and Tasting Dinner.
- Members must inform Events of dietary requirements & names at least 48hrs prior to event
   where possible please provide them when signing up.
- College Evening Meals are for adults only. Children under 14 are not permitted.
- St Cross Members must meet guests at Porters' Lodge and guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. It is forbidden to sell member tickets to non-St Cross members.
