## Updates to Booking Terms and Conditions to note:

- Please arrive 20 minutes early for all Dinners to allow time to be seated.
- All Evening Meals (Halls, Dinners, Special Dinners, Feasts) bookings will close the Friday prior to the Event. Bookings will now open for 2 weeks before this. Please look at the website for individual event dates.
- Children are welcome to attend **all** lunches at the College. Those under 12 are free of charge and do not need to be booked in.

## Family Hall

- When booking please specify if you need a high chair/booster seat. Please note we have limited furniture for young children.
- Please specify your child's age in their booking. Under 12's will be charged at the rate of **£6 each** for catering. 12+ will be considered an adult for catering purposes.
- Where you have a specific dietary need (such as formula or baby food), please be aware that we cannot warm bottles etc. We will also need to provide a waiver for you to bring in additional food. Send an email to [mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk](mailto:mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk) and we will provide this for you and book your child in for free.

## Booking Terms and Conditions:

- All bookings for dining events should be made online: [St Cross Meal booking](#) and must be paid for at time of purchase, except for lunch walk-ins.
- All members must present their St Cross College ID Card upon entry to all events.
- Members must inform Events of all dietary requirements & names before the Event booking closes. If provided after booking closes we cannot guarantee we will be able to accommodate these changes.
- For Dinners, allergen and dietary cards will be provided to those who have signed up with a dietary requirement. These must be displayed throughout the dinner.
- Members can bring 3 guests for the Halls, Special Dinners and Tasting Dinner. St Cross Members must meet guests at Porters' Lodge and guests must be accompanied by a member **at all times**.
- College Evening Meals are for **adults only**. Children under 14 are not permitted.
- If you wish to sell your ticket to another St Cross Student, you must submit this information before booking closes to [mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk](mailto:mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk). It is forbidden to sell member tickets to non-St Cross members.
- Any cancellations must be notified prior to Event booking closure. After this time we cannot provide a refund.
- The College reserves the right to restrict bookings for members who do not notify the College of a cancellation, or who do not attend.
- In the rare situation that you are unable to attend Formal Hall due to **exceptional circumstances** then a request can be made to the [Events Manager](#) after the event for a non-attendance refund, either in full or part.

## Fellows:

- Priority booking is now available to all Fellows prior to the bookings opening. Please email [mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk](mailto:mealbooking.queries@stx.ox.ac.uk) with your dinner choices before **Monday 6 January 2025 at 8.30am**.
- GB Fellows are entitled to 2 free dinners per term.

## Evening Meals:

- There is no seating plan for Halls but you should arrive with those you wish to sit with.
- Wine bottles can be purchased for Halls at the time of booking. Please choose between: House White & Red Wine at **£12**. Marcel Martin Chardonnay & Papatruda Pinot Noir at **£14**.
- Only **one Special Dinner** booking per term is permitted.
- For the **Feast** only one booking per member is permitted and no guests are allowed.
- Junior Members are entitled to one discounted **Feast** place per academic year at £20.00. Any further Feast bookings will be charged at £33.79 (plus £18.50 for alcohol).
- Wine is sold "paired with meal" for Special Dinners, Feasts, and Tasting Dinner & Governing Body Dinner.
